Invitation to submit expression of interest to provide an onsite Canteen service at Waikiki Primary School

Waikiki Primary School is seeking expressions of interest for the operation of a Canteen service from the school site, commencing 31st January 2024.

Parent and community feedback indicates that an onsite Canteen service will be well utilised, and a highly valued service to the school community.

Ideally, the canteen would be expected to operate a recess (morning tea) and lunch service from Monday to Friday. The successful operator will need to adhere to the Department of Education <u>Healthy Food and Drink in Public Schools Policy</u>.

Enrolments

The expected enrolment numbers for 2024 is 352 students.

Premises

A purpose-built canteen will be available for use including; multiple bench tops for food preparation, a cool room/refrigerator, oven and cooktop, storeroom/pantry, sinks. Office space will also be made available for administrative tasks.

There is an opportunity for the service provider to utilise the facility outside of canteen operating hour use for private business purposes. Any approved use outside of normal canteen operating hours will be limited to food preparation purposes only.

The successful provider will be required to contact The City of Rockingham Health Services to discuss the proposed use of the school's canteen facility and establish the required Food Premises Risk Rating.

Licence Agreement

The successful provider will be required to sign a 5-year licence agreement with the Department of Education. The licence agreement will include an agreed annual licence fee which is fixed for 12 months and then subject to review.

Process

This process is open to all interested providers. Open expressions of interest are invited in the form of a written statement and should address the following:

- Sample food menus and pricing;
- Proposed hours of operation;
- Annual Licence fee to be paid to the school;
- Staffing ratios and arrangements;
- Complaints policy and procedures;



- Demonstration of previous/current service delivery in similar settings;
- Commitment to sustainable practices; and
- Any other information you wish to provide to support your EOI

After the closing date, all expressions of interest will be considered by the Principal, Deputy Principal and Manager Corporate Services of Waikiki Primary School. From the expressions of interest, up to three providers may be requested to make a formal presentation to the Canteen sub-committee of the Waikiki Primary School. The Waikiki Primary School Canteen sub-committee will make the final recommendation on the selection of the provider. It is anticipated that this process will be completed by **Thursday 8th December 2023**.
